WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 105-05-2515 the Town Council established the Coventry Tax Increment Financing Study Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") the purpose of which is to provide the Town Council comprehensive analyses which accurately estimate the cost for certain municipal and school building capital improvements and to determine the potential for obtaining funding through the use of the Tax Increment Financing Act; and

WHEREAS, the Commission was due to expire on or before April 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish its stated mission, the Commission requires additional time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Coventry Tax Increment Financing Study Commission shall remain in full force and effect pursuant to the provisions of Resolution #105-05-2515 until September 15, 2006 on or before which the Commission shall submit its final report to include final recommendations to the Town Council.
